BACHELOR OF SCIENCE in BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BSBA)

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

BSBA ADMISSION

All students admitted to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration Program must have completed the following:

1. A minimum of 54 semester hours of college-level credit from an accredited institution AND a minimum 2.00 grade point average (“C”) on a 4.00 scale.
2. Prerequisites before entering the BSBA program, which include the following courses:
 - Composition I and Composition II
 - College Algebra (or a higher-level Math)
 - Computer Literacy (or CISC100 – Computer As A Tool)
3. The test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL) with an acceptable score AND taken within the last five years for applicants whose primary language is not English.

GRADUATION

A total of 128 semester hours and a minimum 2.00 grade point average are required, including:

- 54 Credits needed to enter the BSBA program
- 48 Credits from the major program
- 8 hours of upper division elective credit

Remaining credits may be earned through one or more of the following:

1. Documented prior learning experience (Portfolio)
2. Gateway Courses at Tusculum College
3. CLEP Exams
4. DSST Exams
5. Courses from other regionally accredited colleges/universities
6. Concentration Courses

To dual enroll, a student must have a Tusculum College GPA of 2.75 or better.

Total credits for meeting graduation requirements include the following general education core courses:

Creative Arts and Humanities (2 Areas Required) (Art, Literature, Music, Philosophy, Religion, General Humanities, Theatre)	6 Hours
College Algebra and Natural Science	6 Hours
Health/Physical Education	1 Hour
Social Science (2 Areas Required) (Anthropology, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology)	12 Hours
Computer Literacy	1 Course
