Requirements:

- 3.0 cumulative undergrad GPA
- A college level statistics course
- Must submit 2 professional letters of recommendation
- Must submit 1 (250-300 word) essay
- Must provide an updated professional resume that defines duties
- Must have a minimum of 3 years professional experience

General Information:

Designed for professional managers—this degree is somewhere between a typical MBA and an executive MBA. Curriculum blends typical MBA and Organizational Leadership coursework (degree).

Does not focus on quantitative—students will learn to manage materials, money, and people.

Those who start on April 29, 2009 will finish coursework by December of 2010, will have until April to finish capstone independent study project, and will graduate in May of 2011.

Final project will be related to an issue at place of employment. This is your final course—no class time—will work one-on-one with instructor.
