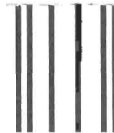
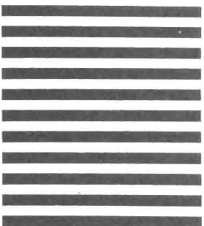

Tusculum College welcomes participants in the 1999 Theologian-in-Residence Program, featuring Tusculum College President Robert E. Knott.

Dr. Knott, who will speak on the history of Christian Doctrine, has a distinguished career in higher education. Before coming to Tusculum College, he was provost and dean of Catawba College in Salisbury, North Carolina. He also served as dean of Arkansas College (now Lyon College) and Gardner-Webb University. He also served ably as Professor of Philosophy at Mars Hill College.

Dr. Knott holds the Bachelor of Science in mathematics and the Master of Arts in philosophy and religion from Wake Forest University. He earned the Bachelor of Divinity degree from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary. He was ordained in the Presbyterian Church and served a pastorate in Winston-Salem, NC. In 1975, he earned the Ph.D. in Higher Education—Philosophy from the State University of New York at Buffalo.

For the past eight years, the College has invited clergy and laypeople to attend this exciting educational opportunity during the month of February. The 1999 Theologian in Residence Series will meet on February 2, 9, 16, and 23. Workshops will be held from 10:00 a.m. until noon at the Holiday Inn in Greeneville. Following a buffet luncheon, we will reconvene at 1:30 p.m. for another hour of discussion. **There is no charge for the workshops or the luncheons.** The 1999 series is being partially funded by a grant from Holston Presbytery.
