“2” means your drug conviction(s) affect eligibility for federal student aid for part of the school year. You should tell the financial aid office at your school your “eligibility date” from question 10 on this worksheet. You can become eligible earlier in the school year if you complete an acceptable drug rehabilitation program. You may still be eligible for state and school aid.

“3” means you are not eligible for federal student aid for this school year unless you complete an acceptable drug rehab program. You may still be eligible for state and school aid.

If you are convicted of possessing or selling drugs after you submit your FAFSA, you must notify the Tusculum College Office of Financial Aid and On-Campus Employment immediately. You will lose your eligibility and must pay back all aid you received after your conviction.

**1** On this worksheet count only federal or state convictions. Do not count any convictions that have been removed from your record, or occurred before you turned 18, unless you were tried as an adult.
